

THREES

The entire spectrum of God-things is expressed by the number three. In Biblical numerology the number three stands for completeness, that which is solid, real, substantial. It is the first of four spiritually perfect numerals (3,7,10 and 12). It indicates something of significance pertaining to the Most High¹, and incorporates a wake-up call.

- Three levels of God's Interests, their hierarchy.
- Three Personalities of the Godhead; the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- Three Heavens.
- Three portions of the Mosaic Tabernacle (M.T.)
- Three realms or dimensions of the Word;
 - Physical typeset.
 - Mentally comprehensible writ.
 - Spiritually discerned comprehension.
- Three eras of God dealing with mankind;
 - Old Testament- God the Father.
 - New Testament- Jesus the Son.
 - Present Age-the Holy Spirit.
- Three witnesses;
 - Water
 - Spirit
 - Blood
- Three 'parts' of man; body, soul and spirit, representing the 'Us' in Genesis.
- Three divisions of sin and sin natures²
- Three stages of sin;
 - Rebellion
 - Self-assertion
 - Making a league with others
- Three realms of physical laws; natural, quantum, sub-quantum.
- Three realms of feeding; being fed (babes), feeding ourselves, feeding others.
- Three levels to 'hearing'; ears, mind, spirit.
- Three parts of the human brain.

In all of these there is an overlapping, a connection between each stage or level; e.g. the physical body houses the mind, which directs the body's actions. The spirit of a man is one level or realm inward from the soul. The spirit communicates with the soul but not the body. Similarly each of these above has an inherent overlapping.
