THE RIVER OF TRUE KNOWLEDGE

All the knowledge of the universe was embedded as Second Realm elements in the release and subsequent flow of First Realm 'light'. This is what I term the River of Truth; everything to be known in subsequent eons began to flow outward. As Man progressed, one would step into this flow and derive something of the universe, crudely at first, to be refined by others later. The term, I believe, is called "On the Shoulders of Giants".

A case in point; according to historians, Newton and Leipnitz 'discovered' the mathematics of calculus, independently of one another, at the same time. Now calculus had always existed; it will always exist until this creation ceases. Newton and Leipnitz, by virtue of several things such as inherent IQ, meditation, self-application and perseverance 'stepped into' this flow of knowledge. (Of the four aspects, meditation is by far the most important, a point to be addressed later).

I used the term "Elohim" because of not only the meaning of the word itself, but also because of Genesis 1:26, where it says clearly, "Let <u>us</u> make man in <u>our</u> image. This clearly establishes Man has three parts, made after the 'us' in Heaven. The physical is the expression of the Son, the first realm. The soul, or mental, is the expression of the Father, the second realm. The spirit is the expression of the Spirit, or the third realm.

It is clear, then, that man has three 'parts', or dimensions, just as God does. So indeed, *all that exists* has three realms or dimensions, the universe included¹. The Mosaic Tabernacle (q. v.) accurately depicts how things are structured, and its symbolism forms a bridge for our minds to understand.

Believers have a hard time grasping this idea of physical things being the only dimension of existence. It is well-accepted that the human body has two more dimensions embedded within it, soul and spirit separate and distinct from the outer shell.

So why is it so difficult to grasp other physical entities also have three dimensions, the unseen embedded within the visible outer shell?

- or blur the incident of Jesus and the fig tree? The correct meaning of Him saying anything to the tree was that He 'answered' it, meaning that the tree must have already said something to Jesus, outside the range of human hearing. The context would support the concept that the tree mocked Jesus; thus Jesus answered it in the way He did, and cursed it.
- or that a given cell, known to exhibit altruism, precise communication and rushing to the aid of other parts of the body? Are these not inner realm traits?

- or that the blood itself has two other dimensions embedded within the physical. The Bible mentions at least twice that "the blood cries from the ground", defined as an audible sound heard by God. It also says the *life* is in the blood, and the penalty for eating the blood of a slain animal was severe.

- or that the entire universe has embedded within it **ALL** knowledge, being obvious that knowledge resides *someplace*. And a third, spiritual realm? –for scientists with special receivers have 'heard' music coming from the heavens.

ALL things made by God through Christ have three dimensions, A-L-L things!

Therefore there is a Third Realm embedded² within the "Let there be light" as well as there is a Second Realm of knowledge; herein are all the aspects of the deepest part of God, His Soul and Spirit and all that pertains to Him. Keep in mind the parallel existence in all three realms of their mirror images; of 'light', darkness, of true knowledge, ignorance and deceit, of good, evil.
