

## TRUE WORSHIP

Isaiah 58:6-14

Verse 6 - Isn't this the covering of the mouth that is acceptable to me? To break free from the fetters and pain of moral iniquity by violently shaking off the yoke of burdens and setting free those you discourage; those that crack into pieces from the struggle, exempt them from your bondage. Root out and tear off all of their yokes.

Verse 7- Isn't this the covering of the mouth that is acceptable to me? To distribute raw ingredients so the famished can feed themselves, and to carry into your family home those you have browbeat and your maltreatment has caused to be an outcast, miserable and destitute. When you perceive someone is naked, that you clothe him, that you do not veil your eyes from the condition of mankind.

Verse 8- Then will your brightest, most luminescent happiness rip open as the dayspring; and I will cause restoration of soundness and wholeness to swiftly sprout in you; your prosperity and moral rightness will precede you; the splendor of the self-existent and eternal Jehovah will put this all together for you.

Verse 9- Then when you accost and cry to the Lord when you meet Him, He'll pay attention; and when you halloo for help, I'll say, "here I am." If you eschew and put away your yokes, if you'll withdraw your seizing and grasping hands, and if you'll turn off your pronouncing of strictly nothingness about yourself;

Verse 10- And if you furnish your vitality to the famished, and fill to satisfaction those you've dealt harshly with and those whose vitality you browbeat, then will illuminating happiness shoot forth beams in your dark misery, so that your dark misery will change and be like a double light in a window.

Verse 11- And the self-existent eternal Jehovah will perpetually transport you; and in the dazzling white desert will fill to satisfaction your soul; and will strengthen your bones for fight; and you will be like an abundantly soaked, protective and fenced garden; and like a source of water or life whose source can not fail.

Verse 12- And those that are with you will begin to obtain children and build and repair the concealed, decayed places; and you will establish a foundation on which many generations will dwell; and you will be addressed as " the mason repairer of the breach and gap", "the one who turned back to inhabit the beaten tracks."

Verse 13- If you turn around and walk away from doing your own desire and valuable purpose on my hallowed and dedicated day of repose, and address this as a luxurious and pleasant intermission, consecrated to the self-existent eternal Jehovah, abounding with honor and giving heavy honor to Him, not trodding along on your own course of life of acquiring your own valuable thing or declaring your own advice:

Verse 14- Then will you luxuriate yourself in the soft, pliable self-existent eternal Jehovah, and He will carry you in the elevated places of the nations, and consume you with Jacob your patriarch's portion and estate... for the self-existent eternal Jehovah has puffed, blown away and scattered into the corners these commands.

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
