STITCHING

The human being, made after the image of Elohim, is comprised of His three personality expressions: the First realm, the physical body; the Second realm, the soul comprised of the conscious and subconscious mind, the emotions and the will; the Third realm, the spirit. These are the three realms or dimensions of the human. If and when one is born *again* by the Spirit, that person acquires a new Third realm, the Innermost eternal spirit. Thereby, the Innermost part of Man is healed, 'stitched' together, or made whole again.

But then a war begins, for the re-born spirit is the Spirit of God Himself, and He cannot co-exist in peace with anything that is not of Himself. Within the re-born man there is this Spirit, trying to argue with a twisted conscious mind, a warped, inaccessible subconscious and a corrupt body with its habits and desires of the flesh. The plan is that this re-born person is to ingest the written Word on a daily basis, in order to re-generate the conscious mind into correct thinking, to align itself with the Spirit within him. That creates the war, either obedience to His Word or rebellion against it.

The overwhelming majority of sicknesses, curses and resultant judgments of all kinds originate out of rebellion against God, either directly by us or requited/recompensed to us via the sins of our leaders and forefathers. There are dozens of examples in both Testaments. II Samuel 21 illustrates the principle of the universality of curses inflicted upon the whole because of the sin of one man; I Cor. 11:29-30 quite clearly illustrates the premise of sickness and death inflicted upon the individual by his act alone. Both the Old and New Testaments use the word 'heart' to convey the seat of the mind, emotions and affections. The word 'heart' in those testaments means 'the middle', or the 'midst', they not knowing much about the internal aspects of man, much less the brain. It is now known specifically all the emotions, long-term memories and subconscious desires occupy the middle brain; there lie most of the sinful soulish desires of man.

We readily accept the idea that healing or renewal of the *spirit* is by the grace of God upon a combination of admission, confession, repentance and contrition. Why then cannot we accept the same process for healing of the *soul* (mind, will and emotions) and to some extent, the physical *body*?

Many, but not all, reversals ('healing') of sin-induced sicknesses (and judgments¹) occur when the Word is spoken or obeyed directly. More commonly, it is when the Word of the Most High has been gnawed, chewed, studied, pondered and meditated until it has been inculcated into the conscious mind. As the Word is stored in the conscious mind, it begins to dominate the corrupt portion of the middle brain, gradually transforming the subconscious middle brain. It is in the latter that the soulish part of man exists, and in which the "flesh" exerts itself with all its inbred affections, desires and carnal bents. The Holy Spirit, Who dwells in the blood, makes His rounds in the body about 1500 times a day, circling throughout the brain. To whatever degree the Word is stored there, He 'picks it up' and carries it to the uttermost parts of the body. As this spiritual 'food' is disseminated throughout at cellular level, healing takes place; i.e., there is a *symbiotic communication,* a spiritual witness if you will, at DNA level of the Word, now become spirit, between what the Almighty said and the developing cells. Herein mutations, divisions (hence the word 'stitching'), tumor cells, 'rebellious' cells and other cellular morphs contrary to Divine design are made right. All of this occurs in the Second and Third realms. More often than not, this occurs upon belief; real, true belief.

The Omniscient, Eternal One communicates with every particle of His universe continually, effortlessly and instantaneously at the most elemental level of its existence. Every component of every animate or inanimate being is immediately subject to His sovereignty, whether it be a trout in Montana or one of 500 billion cells in your body. Healing of any and all cells is no different. The human brain *can* communicate both voluntarily and involuntarily with *all* parts of the physical body; we just don't do it, or even believe we can. And yet we mouth all day long "we have the mind of Christ." If we say that, why don't we do it? *Is it ever stated that Jesus was ever sick?*

TRUTH, AS DEFINED BY WHAT GOD SAID.

Truth is a most difficult thing to obtain. Despots and manipulators for centuries have brought about its deceptive presence by contrivance and repetition of a lie. This occurs until the masses have heard it so long they ascribe truth to what they have heard. Indeed, much of what we assume to be truth today is what we have heard from others over a long period of time.

Like all major fields, Truth has three realms or dimensions. The first realm contains what is *apparently* Truth on the surface of things. Much of what one hears from the "news", gossip and tradition is primarily for the consumption of the masses.

The second realm contains what appeals to the intellect, often expressed by repetition of scholarly and high-sounding words. Usually these are little more than extremely wellwritten plagiarisms; true in the main, but high-tech plagiarism nonetheless. The predominantly Godless populations of science and academia fall into this category, resulting in delusion and perpetuation of the arrogant and self-exalting.

The first and second levels serve as seals to obscure and confuse the recipient, leaving the true Seeker unfulfilled. The first will have a taint, a grain of truth; the second two grains. The third will have three grains, one of the numbers that is perfect and complete. Like so much else in God's economy, one must experience and comprehend what one does *not* want in order to appreciate and know what he *does* want. So it is with truth; one must know what it is <u>not</u> in order to know what it is.

I have learned the hard way truth is reserved for those who are of a mind to glorify the Most High, for it is from Him alone are the roots of Truth are revealed. This paper reveals what I believe I have heard from Him over the last few months. *It deals with our thoughts and how they affect us in body and soul.* It is not intended to be a technical paper, nor include all the various details which make up the given subject.

5/17/15 Again I have found the hard way that Truth, again defined by what God said, is really not appreciated nor sought by *the majority* of so-called believers of this generation, or better said, for *these* generations upon us. This is true for the simple fact Truth messes up their well-set lives; it messes up their control of things, personal control of their surroundings and social calendar. Truth disrupts one's personal stance, however that may be defined, that has become indurate over years of polishing. Stance is often another way of saying arrogance, though it is not perceived as such. Truth, then, is indeed angering, disruptive of people's comfort zones. Anger is the tell-tale sign.

5/19/15 Troubled, I am reminded of a cold winter day on the ridge down in the bottom lands of the ranch; I was troubled that day, deeply so, at the impending ruin of a close friend. As I walked up onto the ridge in the face of a 30-mile an hour wind, I *screamed*,

"Why doesn't he do something?" -"He doesn't know."

"Why doesn't he know?" -- "He doesn't want to know."

"Why doesn't he want to know?" -He doesn't believe I meant what I said."

"Why doesn't he believe you meant what you said?" – "He doesn't believe I said anything. The truth of the matter is that he does not even believe I exist."

End of conversation. Anger reveals not wanting to know, amongst other things.
